

## VISITING PROFESSORS

### Launching new ideas and cooperations with guest scientists—during the pandemic even remotely

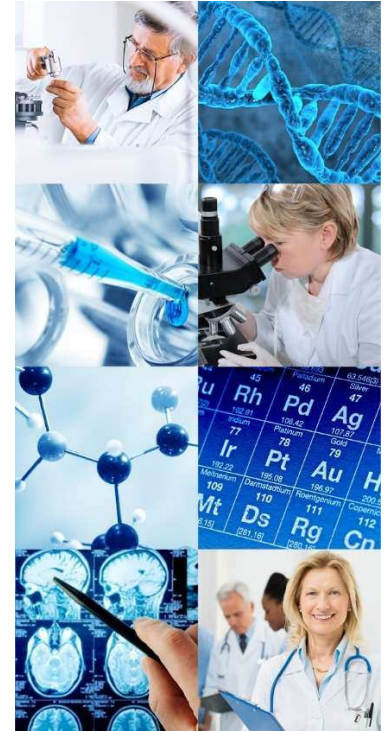
Stiftung Charité offers a wide range of funding programs to attract fascinating personalities and renowned scientists and innovators from abroad to the life and medical sciences in Berlin. With the Visiting Professors, leading scientists from abroad or from other locations in Germany are recruited for guest stays at Charité – Universitätsmedizin Berlin, Berlin Institute of Health (BIH), and Max Delbrueck Center for Molecular Medicine. Due to the SARS-CoV-2 pandemic, physical stays in Berlin can be replaced partly and temporarily by remote work alternatives.

Visiting Professors may come from abroad or from other locations in Germany. The guest stays in Berlin or the potential remote cooperation should have a total duration of three to nine months (continuous or flexibly split over a maximum of two years). They are not designed to conduct a specific scientific project, but to develop and to foster new and big research ideas and collaborations, together with the Berlin host institution.

With funds from its Private Excellence Initiative Johanna Quandt, Stiftung Charité supports Visiting Professors with a maximum of 15,000 Euro per month.
